Please know that in the event of an extended school closing, LISG is prepared to work remotely. The following outlines the protocol for the Middle and Upper School Students. Please read it with your child(ren) and sign the acknowledgement below or respond to this email stating you are aware that the online program will be required.

Student Etiquette:

1. Dr. Geyer will send out a start date.
2. Use your schedule to virtually meet your teachers.
3. Study Hall and Lunch periods: no check in required.
4. Specials: (computer, gym, music, and art). Teachers may send you an assignment via email.
5. Classes will follow the same daily schedule using an online platform like GoogleMeet, which is free and a part of the Gmail format.
6. Show up on time because attendance will be taken.
7. Mute yourself to eliminate background noise.
8. Remember that you are online and seen. Therefore, dress accordingly and avoid the use of your phone.
9. You can “pin” the teacher so you are not distracted by your classmates.
10. You can type in the “chat” if you have a question or comment.
11. You are not permitted to take a screenshot or photo during the session. Failure to comply will have social media consequences listed in the handbook.
12. The online class is your class. Engage as if you were in school.
